Coalition Surge Test: Summary

- Annual exercise requirement for the HPP Grant
- Tabletop exercise with Functional elements
- “Low/No-Notice” Exercise:
 - Low Notice: Coalition members are notified that an exercise will occur within a two-week window.
 - Facilities will **not** know ahead of time whether they are the “evacuating” or “receiving” facility.
- Simulated evacuation of at least 20% of the HCC acute-care bed capacity.

Coalition Surge Test: Summary

The CST is broken into 2 phases:

- Phase 1:
 - Tabletop Exercise with Functional Elements (90 min)
 - Facilitated Discussion (~120 min)
- Phase 2:
 - After Action Review (30-45 min)

Coalition Surge Test: Performance Measures

- Time (in minutes) for evacuating facilities in the HCC to report the total number of evacuating patients
- Time (in minutes) for receiving facilities in the HCC to report the total number of available beds
- Time (in minutes) for the HCC to identify an appropriate mode of transport for the last evacuating patient
- Percent of patients at the evacuating facilities that are identified to be (a) discharged or (b) evacuated to confirmed receiving facilities
- Percent of evacuating patients with an appropriate bed identified at a receiving facility within 90 minutes
- Percent of evacuating patients with acceptance for transfer to another facility that have an appropriate mode of transport identified in 90 minutes

- Exercise Scope

 - e.g. "hospital(s) required to evacuate"

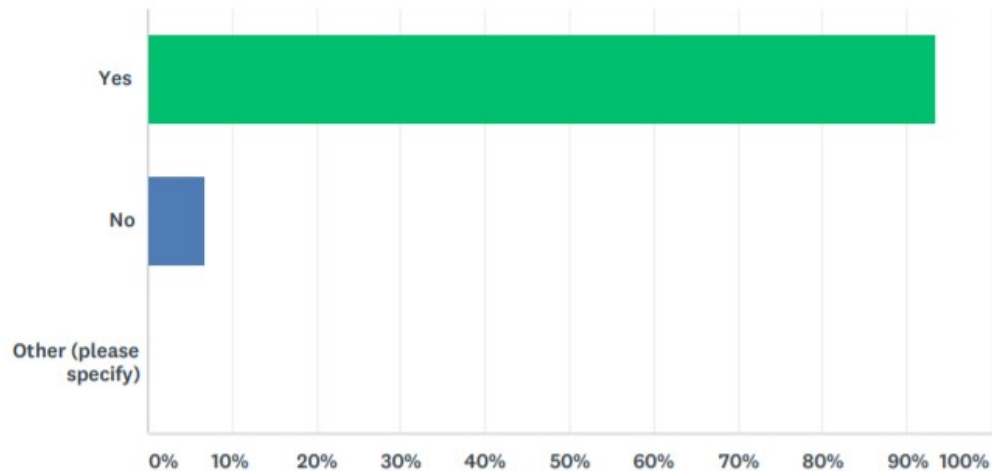
Exercise Objectives and Capabilities

2017-2022 Health Care Preparedness and Response Capabilities	Exercise Objectives
Medical Surge	Assess the ability of an evacuating facility and its coalition partners to rapidly shift into disaster mode
Health Care and Medical Response Coordination	Determine if an evacuating facility knows who to contact during an evacuation
	Assess the coalition members' ability to communicate and coordinate quickly to determine available beds and transportation resources for evacuated patients
	Test the coalition's ability to perform a simulated evacuation with existing on-site staff during a low/no-notice event

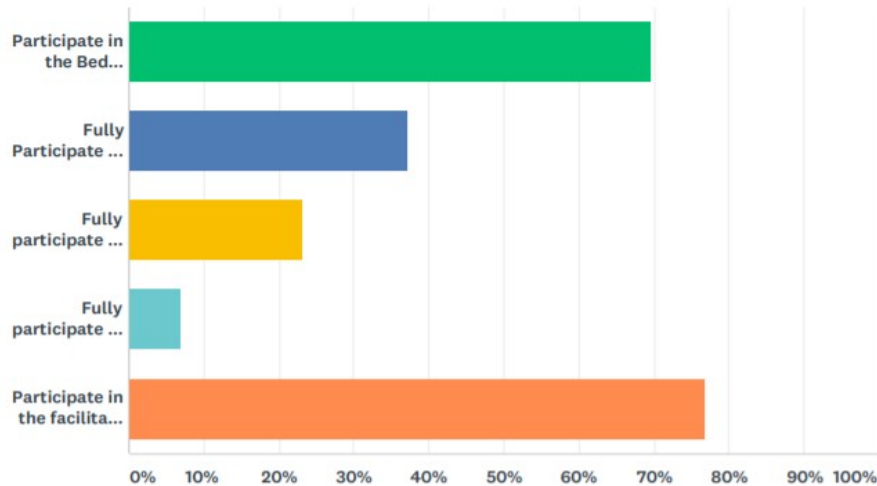
