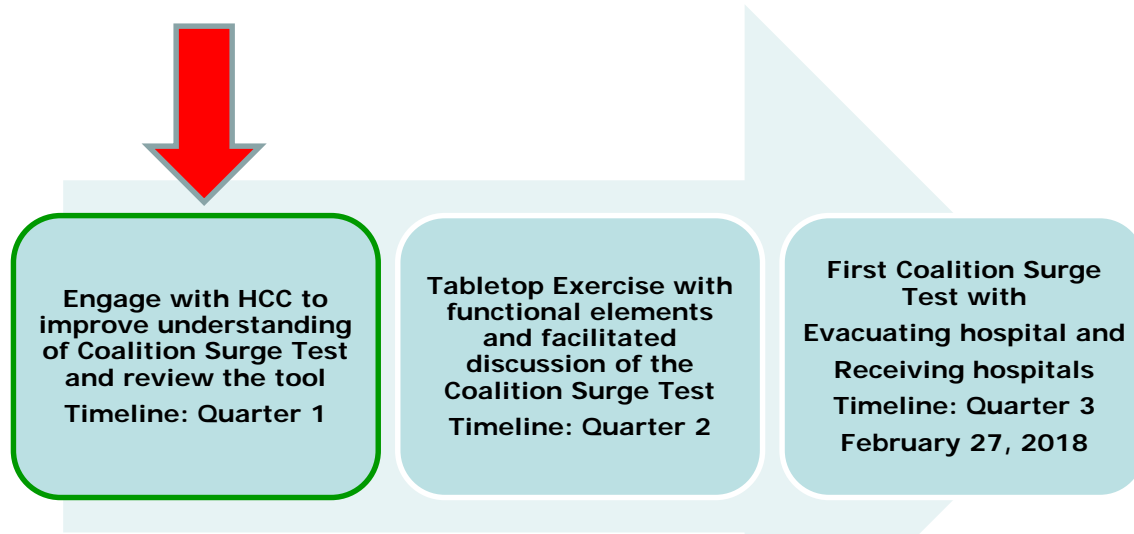

- 4) Chemical Exposure, External
- 5) Small Medium Size Internal Spill
- 6) Mass Casualty Incident, Trauma
- 7) Temperature Extremes
- 8) Information Systems Failure
- 9) Mass Casualty Incident, Medical / Infectious

# Management of Medical Surge



**Activity:** Conduct Health Care Facility Evacuation Planning and Execute Evacuations

**How:** Use Coalition Surge Test

## Role of the HCC in this exercise

1. Collaborate & coordinate with health care response entities to identify clinically appropriate beds for evacuating patients
2. Communicate & coordinate with medically appropriate transportation
3. Identify essential elements of information that helps inform situational awareness among HCC members and partners
