COVID-19 Therapeutics Enrollment Guide

Enrollment Overview

Providers wishing to request COVID-19 monoclonal antibodies (therapeutics) from the State of Texas' allocations at no cost will need to be enrolled as a therapeutics provider. All enrolled COVID-19 therapeutics providers must have a Health Partner Order Portal (HPOP) account. If you would also like to request Sotrovimab and Bebtelovimab, then you will also need access to the Vaccine Allocation & Ordering System (VAOS).

This guide will walk you through how to setup an HPOP account and, if applicable, how to gain access to VAOS.

The therapeutics DSHS distributes through VAOS may vary as the information and situation around COVID-19 changes. 




- 1. Complete the HPOP enrollment forms sent from the therapeutics help desk.

What is HPOP?

The Health Partner Ordering Portal (HPOP) is a system developed and maintained by US HHS. HPOP is currently used for three therapeutics: Paxlovid, Molnupiravir, and Evusheld. As of January 5, 2022, DSHS will allocate to and place orders for these therapeutics on behalf of a select groun of facilities that follow.
