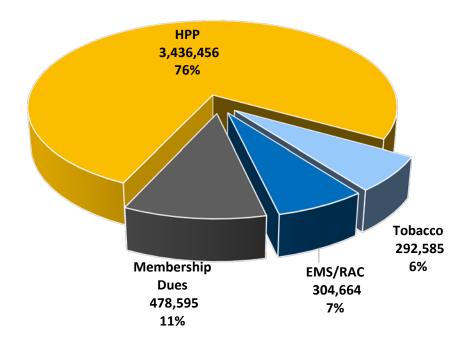

#### **Highlights/Assumptions**

#### **Revenue:**

- HPP remained flat
- EMS/County funding remained flat
- Tobacco funding increased 1%
  - -Compared to total FY18 EMS/TOB funds received
- RAC funding increased 3%
- Membership Dues remain flat

#### **Expenses:**

- Personnel Cost based on staff of 23 FTE
  - EHS Professional Development position added
  - -Cost of Living Increase of 2.48%
- Fringe benefits calculated at 31% based on experience
- Data services cost reduced by \$8K from FY18 budget (SAS-Perinatal RDC)
- Prof Dev-Grants & Staff Dev removed from budget (\$3,800-did not spend in FY18)
- Added provision for Website Phase 2 Build
- All other cost carried forward from FY18
