FALLS PREVENTION TASK FORCE



A Matter of Balance (AMOB) classes start at 7 locations in Fort Worth or Tarrant County through our partners in June 2017.

FWFD responded to 1,427 falls with injury in 2016. Of those falls, 61% of persons were 60 years or greater in age.

Collaboration continues with our local faith communities and the FWFD for home assessments.

DISASTER PREPAREDNESS TASK FORCE
