#### Facilitated Discussion: Overview

#### Facilitated Discussion: Overview

- Discussion focused on:
  - Where patients were sent
  - Transportation assets utilized
  - Other issues that are from the simulated evacuation

#### Facilitated Discussion: Patient Beds

- Evacuating Facilities: (complete for each Evac Facility)
  - Patient census at the start of the exercise?
  - Were any patients discharged? How many?
  - How long did it take to complete the patient count and report?
  - How long did it take to receive confirmation of beds for the evacuating patients?
  - Confirm the number of patients that were accepted in each category of beds.





## Facilitated Discussion: Patient Beds Evacuating Facilities

- How did the evacuating facilities decide who to call?
- Were there any criteria missing that should have been factored into the decision of which facilities to call?
- How did the evacuating facility establish communications with receiving facilities?





## Facilitated Discussion: Patient Beds Receiving Facilities

- Did your response reflect your current "usual" free bed capacity?
- How could you increase capacity at your facility?
- If this had been a real event, would your response be any different?





#### Facilitated Discussion: Transportation

- \*Complete for each Evacuating Facility
- What transportation organizations were contacted?
- How many vehicles were offered by each?
- Evacuating Facilities: describe the transportation assets provided for your patients.





### Facilitated Discussion: Transportation

- What went well with procuring patient transportation?
   Challenges?
- Would there be enough capacity left in the system to handle daily operations?
- Was the HCC able to find enough vehicles to evacuate its patients?





## Facilitated Discussion: Patient Tracking and Communication

- How would patients be tracked as they moved from one location to another?
- How would medical records be transferred?
- How would facilities manage calls from families?
- What can the coalition or NCTTRAC do to assist?
- What should the coalition do to prepare for this scenario?





## Facilitated Discussion: At Risk Populations

- Who are considered at-risk populations?
- How did evacuating facilities determine the order in which patients should be evacuated?





### Facilitated Discussion: Continuity of Operations

- How would discharged patients be cared for during an evacuation and afterwards?
- Can staff be transferred from one facility to another?
   How would they be credentialed?
- Where would facility command staff operate from if the facility was unsafe or unusable?
  - Are there business continuity plans in place?
